Thank you for requesting a Team Registration Packet. The tournament fee is \$300.00 per team. The first eight fully completed Team Registration Packets received with at least a non-refundable down payment of \$150.00 will participate in the tournament. **Please Review:** All teams must have a Player Verification/ID Book – The book must include the following: 1. Multiple typed player lists of player names (first and last names) listed in order by game jersey number. 2. Must have an individual file for each player using a clear page saver sheet containing the following in numerical order of home game jersey numbers: A. Individual “waist to head” photo of player wearing home game jersey with visible jersey number, B. Copy of Code of Conduct/Waiver Form, and C. Copy of official birth certificate (with state seal present).

**Reminder:** Tournament Drawing will take place on Tuesday, November 17, at 9:00 pm at Rooster’s Wings (103 North Springboro Pike, Dayton, Ohio 45449). Team representation is not required. On Wednesday, November 18 the game schedule, brackets and field locations will be emailed.

**Cost:** \$300.00 per team (minimum of two games), fee includes: 8 minute quarter game clock (5 minute halftime), 3-man referee crew, first place individual trophies and 2<sup>nd</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> team trophies and individual medallions, and player/coaches gifts. **Admission:** \$5.00 per adult (per day), all school age children are free. No charge for coaches, players, team moms, cheerleaders and cheer coaches.

**Other Details:**

- Teams are certified, books are checked and players weighed in one hour before first game time, teams are rechecked one hour before each game time thereafter.
- Team ID books must include: 1. Multiple printed team rosters in jersey numerical order, and 2. Player ID’s – waist up player photos with jersey, signed conduct/waiver form, copy of original birth certificate, and 3. Signed conduct/waiver forms for all coaches. Each player’s documents must be kept in a separate plastic page protector (place photo in front of signed conduct/waiver form with birth certificate copy placed facing back), all pages must be in numerical team jersey order, placed in a 3-ring binder.
- Teams provide: game ball, first aid, and water. Team coolers only.
- All games start with prayer with both teams at the middle of the field.
- Team captains will flip for ball choice; upper bracket team is home team, home teams manage down markers.

## **(In Part NYSCA Code of Ethics)**

- General – I will: cheer for both teams positively, treat refs fairly, supervise mine or be supervised at all times, park responsibly, remain in directed areas, show respect to the facility, and throw trash away in proper containers.

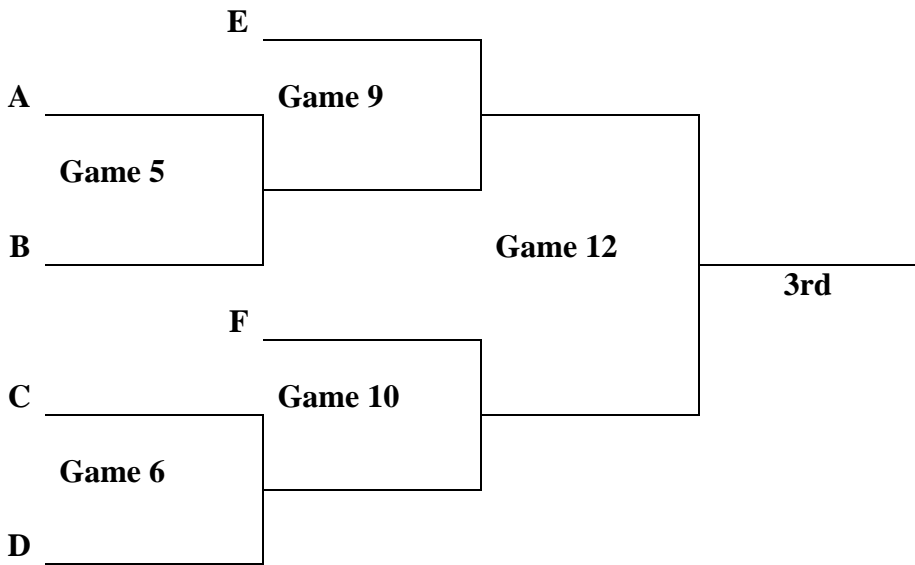
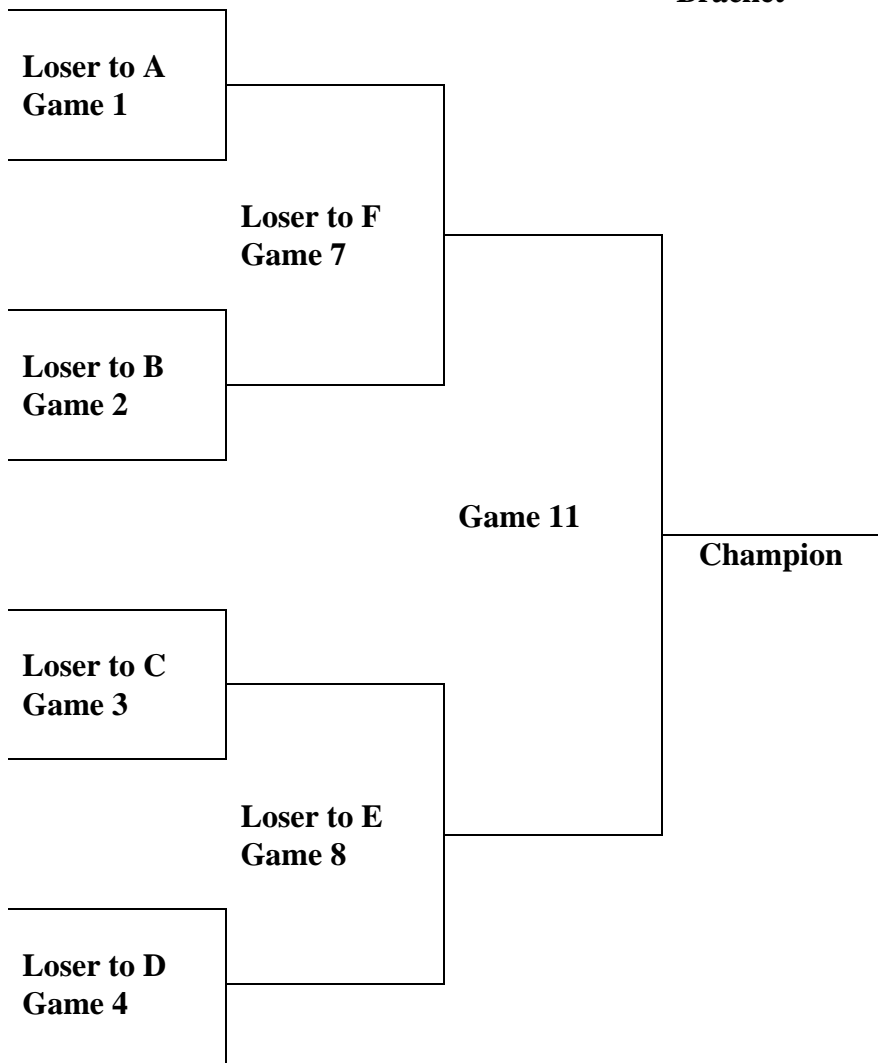

## **Supplemental Tournament Rules**

- Tourney rules are posted at [www.kingdomfootball.org](http://www.kingdomfootball.org) these rules are in addition to those.
- If in any event the scoreboard is inoperable the game clock will be kept by referees on the field.
- Punts (10U) and extra points kicks (10U and younger) must be made within a 5 second referee count or a penalty (punt) will be assessed or the play will be nullified (extra point).
- A running clock will be utilized in the second half when a team is ahead by 25 points or more. The play clock will not be stopped until the score difference falls below 25 points.
- Stadium/Sideline communication devices may be used and do not need to be provided for both sides.
- Ball sizes include: 6U Peewee, 8U Peewee, 10U Peewee or Junior, 12U Junior or Youth, 14U Youth.
- Regular OHSAA rules will apply to any overtime situation. Teams must go for two if a second overtime occurs.
- All players and coaches will be given ID wrist bands at the weigh-in, these bands must be worn at all times, if detached the coach and player must be recertified, keep team books with the head coach at all times.
- All players exceeding their respective skill weight will be identified by a special colored wristband, these bands are not to be removed, and teams found playing overweight players at skill positions will forfeit games and/or be ejected from the tournament.
- For any record tie breaker situations, the following procedures will be followed: head to head, least total points scored upon, greatest differential between total points scored and total points scored upon, coin toss.
- Any topic not discussed will follow OHSAA rules.
- Medical personnel will not be onsite. If there is an injury that requires medical attention, call 911, or seek medical attention from a nearby medical center or hospital.
- The field director and/or tournament director will have the final decision in any discrepancies or issues that may arise during the games.
