The PSA Spring 2010 soccer registration is now open for teams and individuals. A blank roster, a game conflict report and 2010 Spring Soccer Information Sheet. If you are going to coach this spring, here is a brief overview of the season and registration process.

Registration:

- **Returning Teams:** The deadline for all returning teams to register is January 15, 2010. We encourage you to fill out the team roster with all your returning players' information. Collect the fees in the form of Visa, MC, and Discover, AMEX or check and bring your completed roster, fees and game conflict report to PSA by the registration deadline. Please don't forget to have your parent sign in the appropriate places.

- **New Teams:** The deadline for all new teams to register is January 22, 2010 we encourage you to fill out the team roster with all your players' information. Collect the fees in the form of Visa, MC, and Discover, AMEX or check and bring your completed roster, fees and game conflict report to PSA by the registration deadline. Please don't forget to have your parents sign in the appropriate places.

Overview of the season:

- **Leagues:** Boys and Girls 3yr olds-7th grade. Grade assignments will be based on the players' current grade. Pre-K (3-5 yr olds) assignments are based on the current age of the player.

 - **Pre-K 3's:** Players must turn 3 yrs old by January 1st 2010.

 - **Pre-K 4/5's:** Players must be between the ages of 4-5 and **NOT** in kindergarten.

Players: Players may only participate on one team in the PSA soccer league. Players may play in their grade **OR** choose to play up ONE GRADE LEVEL. The Pre-K league players are restricted to playing in their age group only!

****A 3 yr old player may not play in the 4/5 yr old league. ****

●**Divisions:** Depending upon the number of teams in each grade level, teams will be divided into separate divisions based upon competitive levels. In the third - seventh grades, there may only be one division based upon number of teams registered.

●**Schedule:** The season will be 8 games plus playoffs for 3rd grade and above. The season opens Saturday February 13, 2010 for 3rd grade and above and Saturday February 20th for Pre k through 2nd Grade and runs through Sunday April 25, 2010. Most games will be played on Saturdays. Rainouts or rescheduled games may be played on Sundays or weeknights.

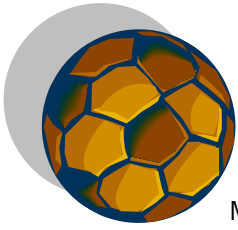

GAME CONFLICT GUIDELINES

Season Scheduling Information

Season begins: Saturday February 13th – 3rd Grade Leagues through 7th leagues
Saturday February 20th – Pre K Leagues through 2nd Grade League

You will have a game on all available weekends (Saturday or Sunday).

NOTE: We may schedule teams during the week to allow for rainout reschedules later in the season. As we reschedule games due to rainouts, the make up games may be placed on a weeknight

All teams must play on March 13th we will not honor a conflict for this date

Saturday Conflicts - Due to scheduling constraints we are unable to honor conflicts for an entire Saturday; however, you may request to play at a specific time. This includes Religious or Holy Days that fall on the weekend.

Every effort will be given to conflict requests, provided they:

- Are received at Plano Sports Authority by the deadline indicated above; and,
- Qualify as a conflict as defined below; and,
- Affect the number of players specified below.

Reschedules & Conflicts:

We will take conflicts into consideration when rescheduling rainouts/make up games; however, please be aware that we may not have the flexibility to honor all conflicts due to field availability.

CONFLICT CATEGORIES:

- If the majority of your team can not make your game
- Head coach of multiple teams

NUMBER OF PLAYERS AFFECTED:

- Must reduce the number of players available to less than that required to field a team.

Pre K 3, 4 and 5 year olds: less than 3 players remain available

Kindergarten and first graders: less than 3 players remain available

Second graders: less than 4 players remain available

Third and fourth graders: less than 6 players remain available

Fifth through seventh grade: less than 7 players remain available

Coaches' Code of Ethics

I will:

- Consider it a privilege to coach children.
- Remember I am a youth coach and that the game is for children and not adults.
- Consider it an obligation to be an example while developing character, integrity and honesty.
- Use positive coaching methods to make the experience enjoyable, increase self-esteem and foster a love and appreciation for the sport.
- Place the emotional and physical well being of my players ahead of any personal desire to win.
- Not direct comments or criticism relative to players' game performance.
- Remember to treat each player as an individual.
- Remember the large spread of emotional and physical development for the same age group.
- Provide a safe playing situation for my players.
- Organize practices that teach sports' skills for the players' age I coach.
- Use coaching techniques appropriate for each of the skills that I coach.
- Insure I know the rules of each sport I coach and teach these rules to my players and their parents.
- Lead, by example in demonstrating fair play and sportsmanship to all my players.
- Promote sportsmanship over gamesmanship following the sport's rules with no violation of them to win.
- Not abuse a player physically, verbally, emotionally or mentally.
- Not argue, threaten or demean a player, parents, coaches or officials.
- Not use foul and abusive language at any time in representing PSA.
- Control the emotions, ego, frustrations and displays of anger of myself, players and team parents.
- Not use alcohol, drug or tobacco related products in the presence of players, coaches, officials or volunteers.
- Report any conduct that has violated this code or is detrimental to the positive environment projected by PSA through youth sports.

As a PSA Coach,

- I agree to read the Rules, Policies & Procedures, follow the same and support the PSA sports program.

Safe Kids Program for PSA and the PSA StarCenter

PSA is committed to provide a safe environment and safe environment to prevent sexual misconduct. PSA is committed to:

- Provide a safe environment and to prevent child abuse and sexual misconduct
- Make every reasonable effort to ensure that every person involved in coaching a sport/activity will abide by the Safe Kids guidelines adopted by PSA
- Make every reasonable effort to exclude any adult with a legally documented history of child abuse/molestation or any other conviction or record that would bring unnecessary risk to the health and safety of the participants of our programs

PSA will:

- Take appropriate action on all allegations of child abuse and/or sexual misconduct
- Report all allegations immediately to the authorities for investigation
- Cooperate fully with any such investigation
- The following represents the preventive measures will taken by PSA regarding abuse:
- Physical, emotional, mental, and verbal abuse of any of the participants, coaches, managers, employees, volunteers involved in PSA sponsored activities is not permitted
- Inappropriate touching of any kind is forbidden
- PSA agrees to provide more than one adult working at or overseeing every activity and seek to avoid one-on-one situations. If a child needs special attention (one-on-one training or an individual meeting), it will be handled with the assistance or presence of another adult
- Coaches, volunteers and paid staff should never ride alone with a child or participant in a car. Procedures will be established for coaches, volunteers and paid staff to follow in the event a participant is stranded at a PSA sponsored activity
- Parents are encouraged to attend all PSA sponsored activities
- PSA will review and update these procedures with all coaches, volunteers and paid staff who work with children
- PSA will maintain a list of employees who have reviewed these procedures
- PSA will conduct background checks on volunteer sports' directors; league coaches and coaches
